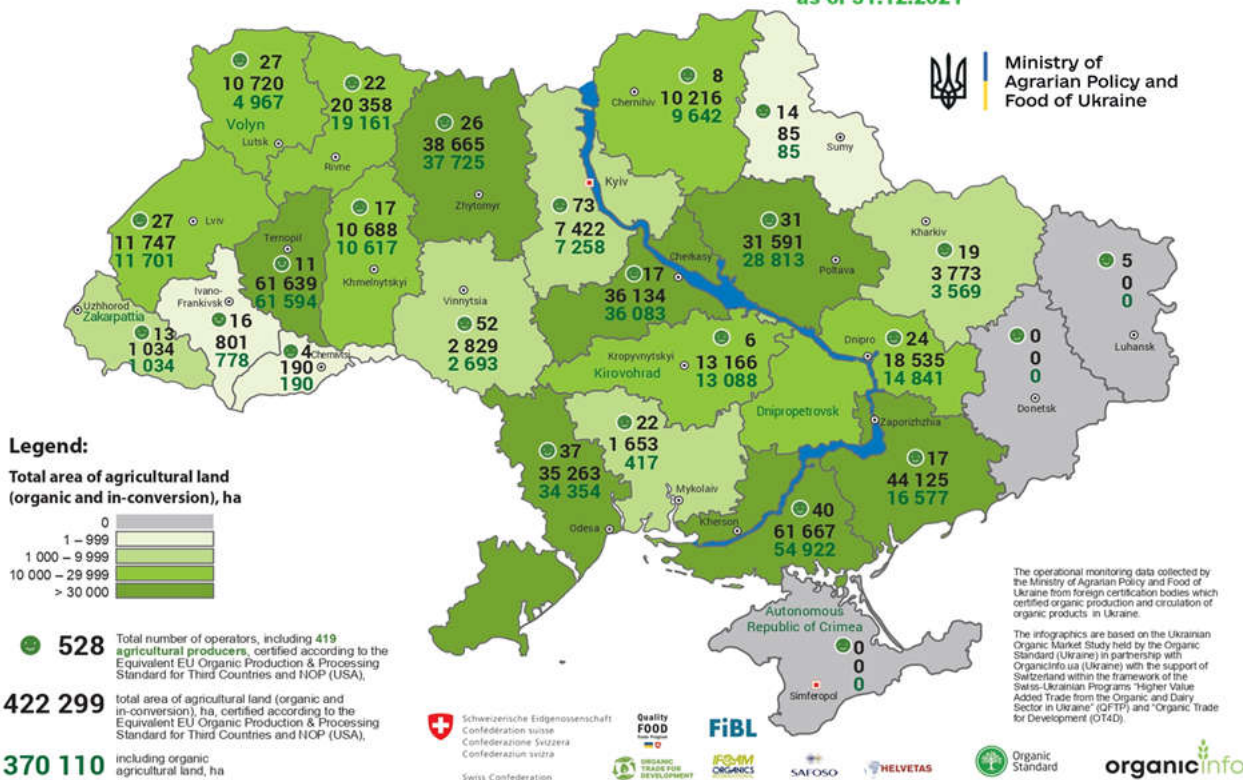

WHAT IS IN PROCESS?



Accreditation of potential certification bodies in accordance with the Law of Ukraine
“On Conformity Assessment Bodies”
(carried out by the National Accreditation Agency of Ukraine)



Finalisation of the **formation of the legal framework for supervision (control)** in the field of organic production, circulation and labeling of organic products
(2 draft orders are being developed, which are supposed to approve the forms of acts for the implementation of state control measures in this area)



Bringing the Law of Ukraine “On Basic Principles and Requirements for Organic Production, Circulation and Labeling of Organic Products” **in line with** the new EU organic Regulation
(corresponding draft of the Law of Ukraine is being developed)

COOPERATION WITH THE EU DURING FULL-SCALE WAR IN UKRAINE:



Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/1450 of 27.06.2022 as regards the use of non-organic protein feed for the production of organic livestock has been applied.

In order to keep the Ukraine's position on the EU markets, the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine appealed to the EU Member States, EU Commission and EU Delegation in Ukraine to confirm the ability of Ukraine to supply the necessary amount of organic feed and not to apply such derogations.



These days the issues related to logistics for the export of Ukrainian organic products and specialised storages for organic products are being addressed (official letters have been sent to Poland and the EU Commission)





EU SUPPORT DURING FULL-SCALE WAR IN UKRAINE:



European Parliament has approved a one-year suspension of the EU import duties on all Ukrainian exports, to support the Ukrainian economy.



European Commission issued the Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/760 of April 8, 2022, amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/2306 as regards the transitional provisions for certificates of inspection issued in Ukraine



The important positive impact on development of the export potential of the Ukrainian organic sector is the European Commission's decision to exclude Ukraine from the list of countries whose organic products are subject to enhanced control measures, which has simplified the export procedures
